

Buy-Ups

Configuring the buy-up



Buy-ups are configured as wash packages. In your wash controller, you will configure your base wash package and your buy-up wash package. The Dencar pay station will signal the base wash package on output X of the Sealevel I/O device and the buy-up wash package on output Y.

For example, the Bronze tier uses output 1 on the Sealevel I/O device. The recommended upgrade tier is output 5. For consistency, we follow the same pattern for each tier:

Bronze = output 1, Bronze buy-up = output 5

Silver = output 2, Silver buy-up = output 6

Gold = output 3, Gold buy-up = output 7

Platinum = output 4, Platinum buy-up = output 8

Buy-ups are configured at the Device level. Go to the device you want to add the buy-up to in the CMP. Scroll down to the Buy-Up section and press the + sign.
